Overland Park Welcomes 2014 Mid-America Regional Playoff

Pittsburgh, PA – The National Club Softball Association is excited to announce that this season's Mid-America Regional Playoff will be held at Blue Valley Recreation Complex in Overland Park, KS.

Located just 10 miles west of the Missouri border, the Blue Valley Recreation Complex features a total of 24 baseball and softball fields, eight concession stands and two batting cages. The facility has been in existence since the early 1980's and is currently being renovated to add another four ball fields. The complex plays host to multiple youth and adult ASA events throughout the year and is a great fit for an NCSA Tournament.



The Blue Valley Recreation Complex and the Overland Park Sports Alliance will welcome the top four Mid-America Conference teams to compete for a Regional Championship. The tournament will be a double-elimination style, seven-game maximum competition and will take place on Saturday, April 26th and Sunday, April 27th on fields North 22 and 25. In addition to a Regional Championship, two berths to the 2014 NCSA World Series are also on the line. Both teams that advance to the Regional Championship will earn invitations to represent the Mid-America Region at the league finale event in Columbus, GA and compete for a national title.



435 Overland Park Place Hotel has partnered with the NCSA and will be the Host Hotel for this regional event. Teams that advance to the 2014 Mid-America Regional Playoff are required to stay at 435 Overland Park Place Hotel, located at 7000 w. 107th Street in Overland Park, KS. The hotel is newly renovated and the NCSA has secured a discounted rate of just \$69.99 per night for double or king rooms. This rate includes a hot breakfast buffet, free parking, Wi-Fi Internet and 10% off at the 435 Bar & Grille.
