Greg Wagner, owner and primary photographer at Wagner Photography, will be on hand to personally handle the photography. Greg’s specialization in sports action (with an emphasis on baseball and softball) began in 1986 with the Chicago Cubs baseball fantasy camp. Although he has had the opportunity to photograph professional baseball as well as NFL and D1 college football, Greg much prefers to work at the amateur level to provide magazine-quality photographs to those who would not normally have such photos available to them.

Each of the teams playing in the NCSA World Series will be photographed in action as the games are being played. The photos will then be on display at Middle Creek Park throughout the tournament with a Wagner staff member on hand to help with the photo ordering process. This will be especially helpful for parents and friends of the players who will not be in attendance.
