Spring Training Showcase Heads Back to Tampa Bay

Pittsburgh, PA – CollClubSports, the National Club Softball Association and the National Club Baseball Association are excited to announce that they will once again be partnering with the Tampa Bay Sports Commission to host the 2016 NCSA/NCBA Spring Training Showcase in Tampa, FL. After a record-setting 75 club baseball and club softball teams attended the 2015 event at Mike Sansone Park in Plant City, FL, anticipation for the 2016 Spring Training Showcase is already building.



Teams will be traveling from around the nation during their Spring Break, and there are three potential dates for the NCSA Spring Training Showcase Tournaments. This year's projected dates include March 4-6, March 11-13, and March 18-20.

All games will be played at Mike Sansone Park in Plant City, FL. The park features two beautiful NCAA Regulation softball fields with four batting tunnels. The field crews and umpires at Mike Sansone Park are a huge part of the success that the Spring Training Showcase has seen over the past few years. With their commitment to excellence and a passion for the game of softball, the 2015 Spring Training Tournaments will be nothing short of a good time.

Costs for the tournament include a one-time non-refundable entry fee of \$350 along with a \$100 refundable performance bond. **Teams' signed contract, schedule request and \$100 performance bond are due by December 1st, 2015.** Teams will also be allowed to play additional games against participating teams that are in Tampa for the week of their Spring Break. Extra games will be \$100 per game and practice will be \$25 per hour of practice. All tournament fees and extra game or practice fees will be due no later the January 31, 2016.



With more than 30 teams interested in attending, the NCSA is securing discounts at local hotels, restaurants and businesses in the Tampa area for your teams. As members of the NCSA, participating teams will also benefit from travel discounts and special rates through AVIS, the Official Rental Car Agency of CollClubSports.
