The University of Oregon defeated Arizona State by a score of 7-4 to win the 2015 NCBA Division I National Championship on Thursday, May 28th at Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Kentucky.



The Ducks went a perfect 4-0 through the seven-day tournament to claim the program's first NCBA League Title. Oregon defeated Florida State, Texas and Iowa State en route to the championship match-up with Arizona State. Behind timely hitting and well-rounded pitching staff, Oregon sailed to winning finish.

The junior lefty took home World Series MVP Honors after an incredible weekend at the 2015 tournament.

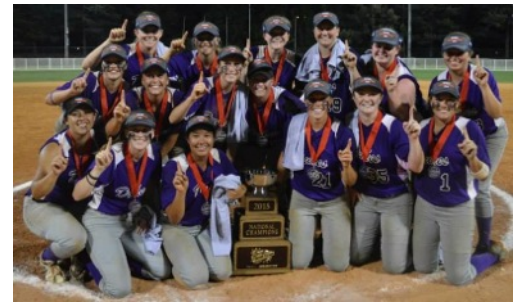

EKU Wins Division II National Championship!

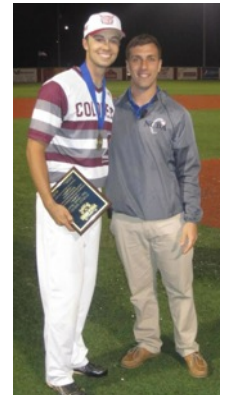
