Botetourt Sports Complex to Host 2015 Mid-Atlantic Regional Tournament

Pittsburgh, PA – The National Club Softball Association is excited to announce that this season's Mid-Atlantic Regional Playoff will be held at Botetourt Sports Complex in Troutville, VA.

Located just 25 minutes north of downtown Roanoke, the Botetourt Sports Complex features a total of 4 collegiate-sized softball fields, a full concession stand and two batting cages. The facility sits within the 125-acre Greenfield Recreation Park. The complex also features full access to public restrooms, an in-game PA Announcer and a Scoreboard Operator. Botetourt is a top-notch complex, and a great fit for an NCSA Tournament.



Botetourt Sports Complex and the city of Troutville will welcome the top four Mid-Atlantic Conference teams to compete for a Regional Championship. The tournament will be a double-elimination style, seven-game maximum competition and will take place on Saturday, April 25th and Sunday, April 26th. In addition to a Regional Championship, two berths to the 2015 NCSA World Series are also on the line. Both teams that advance to the Regional Championship match-up will earn invitations to represent the Mid-Atlantic Region at the league finale event in Columbus, GA and compete for a national title.

Troutville Comfort Inn has partnered with the NCSA and will be the Host Hotel for this regional event. Teams that advance to the 2015 Mid-Atlantic Regional Playoff are required to stay at Troutville Comfort Inn, located at 2545 Lee Highway in Troutville, Virginia. The hotel is newly renovated and the NCSA has secured a discounted rate of just \$99.99 per night for double queen rooms. This rate includes a deluxe hot breakfast, free parking, and complimentary high-speed internet.

To make a reservation, teams should call 1(800) 628-1957 and mention that they are booking with the 'NCSA Mid-Atlantic Regional Tournament' to receive the discounted room rate. All qualifying teams need to have their room reservations made **no later than Tuesday, April 14th**.
