## Clemson Set to Host the 2014 South Atlantic Regional Playoff

Pittsburgh, PA – The National Club Softball Association is excited to announce that this season's South Atlantic Regional Playoff will be held at W.C. Nettles Park in Clemson, SC.

Located just 10 minutes east of The University of Clemson, Nettles Park is Clemson's largest park and holds the administrative offices for the Clemson Parks and Recreation Department. The facility features a total of three lighted softball fields and two baseball fields, as well as a dog park, play park, large picnic shelter and full service restrooms. The complex is currently home to the Clemson Club Softball Team.



Nettles Park and the City of Clemson Parks and Recreation Department will welcome the top four South Atlantic Conference teams to compete for a Regional Championship. The tournament will be a double-elimination style, seven-game maximum competition and will take place on Saturday, April 26<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, April 27<sup>th</sup> at the facility. In addition to a Regional Championship, two berths to the 2014 NCSA World Series are also on the line. Both teams that advance to the Regional Championship will earn invitations to represent the South Atlantic Region at the league finale event in Columbus, GA and compete for a national title.

The Traveling Teams Reservation Department has partnered with the NCSA and the South Atlantic Region to assist all teams in making their discounted hotel reservations for the event. Teams that advance to the 2014 South Atlantic Regional Playoff are required to reserve hotel rooms through Traveling Teams in order to participate.
