Clemson Set to Host the 2015 South Atlantic Regional Playoff

Pittsburgh, PA – The National Club Softball Association is excited to announce that this season's South Atlantic Regional Playoff will be held at W.C. Nettles Park in Clemson, SC.

Located just 10 minutes east of The University of Clemson, Nettles Park is Clemson's largest park and holds the administrative offices for the Clemson Parks and Recreation Department. The facility features a total of three lighted softball fields and two baseball fields, as well as a dog park, play park, large picnic shelter and full service restrooms.

Nettles Park and the City of Clemson Parks and Recreation Department will welcome the top four South Atlantic Conference teams to compete for a Regional Championship. The tournament will be a double-elimination style, seven-game maximum competition and will take place on Saturday, April 18th and Sunday, April 19th at the facility. In addition to a Regional Championship, two berths to the 2015 NCSA World Series are also on the line. Both teams that advance to the Regional Championship will earn invitations to represent the South Atlantic Region at the league finale event in Columbus, GA and compete for a national title.



The Clemson Days Inn has partnered with the NCSA and will be the Host Hotel for this regional event. Teams that advance to the 2015 South Atlantic Regional Playoff are required to stay at Clemson Days Inn, located at 1387 Tiger Blvd. in Clemson, SC. The NCSA has secured a discounted rate of just \$89.00 per night for double queen or single king rooms. This rate includes a continental breakfast, free parking, Wi-Fi Internet, microwaves and refrigerators.
